2011 Junior Pistol Summer Vacation

During the first 9 days of July the PA Junior Pistol Team made a trip down south to attend the USA Shooting Nationals and Progressive Position Pistol (PPP) Nationals. We also conducted the 1st annual PSA BBQ tour.

Darian Shenk and Beth Lutz competed in the USAS Nationals at Ft. Benning, GA. Darian was tied for 8th overall with a 728 and missed the finals by 1 tenth of a point. She was the 3rd highest junior in the match. Beth won her class with a 716. They were awarded their medals by 1984 Sport Pistol Silver Medalist Ruby Fox.

Next, the team moved on to Anniston, AL to compete in the USAS PPP Nationals. This is a Junior only match and Darian and Beth were joined by Caleb Zolko and Mathew Brennen. The PA Team earned a silver medal with a score of 2099-27x. Beth improved her position by one in the finals, finishing 6th. Darian went into the individual finals in first place with a 725. She shot a world class final of 99.9 and won the match. Her performance earned her a spot on the Junior National Development Team and the coveted USA Shooting jacket.

Rifle Team

This summer has been a whirlwind with members of the junior rifle program competing in 8 National Championships as well as several regional competitions. In the second week of June, we hosted the Mid-Atlantic 6400 Prone Championship which is a 4-day match consisting of some of the best prone shooters on the eastern coast. Significant work on the competition range was actually completed by several parents before the match to increase the capacity of the range to help accommodate the number of shooters for the match. The match went very well with 8 of our members competing. In the overall competition, Steve Angeli finished as 1st Expert, Josh Martin as 1st Sharpshooter, and Griffin McElwee as 1st Marksman.

and this was Griffin's first USA Shooting National Championship. Nate fired some good scores taking several class awards in the smallbore events. Both Alyssa and Nate did well in several events finishing in 9th position in the junior category just out of the junior finals. The conclusion of this match marked the end of what I feel a very successful 17-day trip for 3 of the juniors. While this was a taxing trip both physically shooting in 95+ degree temperatures and the mental aspects of 10days of competition, we had only 10 days to rest and prepare for the NRA smallbore nationals at Camp Perry. In that 10-day period, we had a 2-day 3-position regional match in Allentown and a prone league match. During this time, a 3-day mini-camp was also held at the club on the competition range in which the juniors trained from 9am to about 4pm having both breakfast and lunch at the range. In the evenings, we would do something as a group and the juniors (about 15) would stay at my house and prepare dinner and clean up afterwards as small groups. It was a great success both from the aspect of preparing for Camp Perry and as a team-building experience.

At the end of June, there were 3 juniors selected to compete with the PA state team in the NRA 3-position air rifle championships at Camp Perry. The juniors involved were Jessica Smith, Mitchell Kleinfelter, and Caleb Lloyd in the sporter category and Nate Brandenburg, Briann Derr, and Alyssa Gestl in the precision category. The sporter team did very well with each of the individuals shooting a personal best. Alyssa also fired a 1180/1200 to capture 2nd place overall. This was one of two back-to-back air rifle competitions at the Camp Perry CMP range. The Junior Olympics, which was the next match, was attended by 3 Palmyra teams (12 juniors) qualifying in the precision category. No other club has ever qualified to enter three teams. Those attending were Abby Wert, Alex Gestl, Kaleb Hawryluk, Luke Johnson, Kevin Brubaker, Rob Smith, Liz Embeck, Grant Kent, Josh, Nate, Briann, and Alyssa. It was a very interesting and competitive match. After the first day the Palmyra Green team was sitting in a pack of 11 teams within a 15-point range, making the entire match come down to the second day competition. On that second day, the team fired a National record to secure the Club Championship title. As individuals, although no one was in the top 10, the juniors fired tremendous scores showing they belonged there.

Again at the Nationals at Camp Perry, Palmyra showed the strongest contingent of juniors at the smallbore nationals with 18 juniors participating. In the team position events, the top 2 teams finished as 3rd and 4th place Junior in the metallic sight team match and 2nd and 4th Junior in the any-sight team match. To put some perspective on this the only junior teams that were ahead of us were state association (all-star) teams, so our teams did very well. In addition we had 7 juniors staying out for the prone championships. Of special note, Coach Steve Angeli is the Intermediate Senior Metallic Sight Prone Champion. The final national championship was the American Legion tournament held at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs in the beginning of August. Nate and Alyssa were two of the only 15 invited to compete at this national level event. They finished 8th and 10th respectively. The rest of August was taken as a well needed rest for both the juniors and the coaches. We are now back at practice regularly and are preparing for the upcoming season. The first competition in July was the USA National Championships at Fort Benning, GA. We had a total of 6 juniors competing in three different events including prone, 3-position, and air rifle. Those involved were Leo Funk, Griffin, Nate, Briann, Alyssa, and Abby. Again, overall the juniors did well with Alyssa and Abby firing personal bests,
