Please remember, that when you are on a range and someone is down range, required safety procedures are that no firearms are to be handled and the action is always open. We have Open Bolt Indicators (OBI) in the candy machine at a cost of 25 cents. They work very well and are a visual indication that the action is open and the firearm is safe.

This October 13 is our 50th Field Day. Please mark your calendar for this family event and plan to attend. You will be receiving a separate mailing approximately the middle of August. This flyer will contain all the details along with the Field Day gun tickets. I hope that everyone will participate in our biggest fund raiser of the year. I am going to ask that anyone who has been a member for all 50 field days or knows someone who is, please contact me as soon as possible!

We would also like to ask that all members refrain from going into the Law/ Training Range, when it is being used. You can tell this because the **Red Flag** will be sticking out

of the post. The reason I am asking this is two-fold. First, it is a safety issue and the Range Officers are responsible if someone gets hurt. Second, the folks using the range get uncomfortable when they turn around and people are standing there that they do not know. For these reasons I would appreciate everyone's cooperation!

We have added the requirement that all new members must watch the New Member Orientation before they can get their card. Please be aware that this is now a requirement and that the video can be accessed on our Web site. If anyone has any questions please do not hesitate to call me.

In closing, I wish to thank all our members for being a member of Palmyra Sportsmen's. We continue to work hard to maintain and improve our facility for you the member. Please pay attention to information you will be receiving in the mail in the next few weeks as your participation will be very important. Thank you.

- No "bump" firing or slide fire/"bump" fire stocks

These policies were passed by the membership at a club meeting due to safety concerns. The most important factor is to keep **ALL** shots on the back stop. No rounds can leave the range; keep this in mind when you are using any of the ranges. Please remember that gun safety and range safety is **your responsibility**.

Volunteer Program – For New Shooting Range

The Club will be taking on a new project starting April 14, 2013 to build a new shooting range, which will cost approximately \$600,000. We will need a lot of funds to finance this project.

One way in which we would like to accomplish this is by having a fundraising project with Hershey Entertainment complex's (Hersheypark) Volunteer Program. We will supply Hersheypark with workers and they in turn will pay the wages of the volunteer's to the Palmyra Sportsman's Club. Each volunteer (adults only) will receive from the park a voucher to attend the park during this season. This will occur each time we have a volunteer working.

You can sign up to volunteer (and obtain a free voucher to the park) by submitting your name, address, telephone number and email address on the form below and put the form into the box next to our display at the club.

You will then receive via email a set of do's/don'ts for volunteer workers including what to wear (clothing wise) and where to report.

A list of volunteer times will be forwarded to you via email when it is received from Hershey (this is to be done on Tuesdays); you can choose the times you want from that to volunteer. Good advice, get back as quickly as possible because there are 90 agencies who have volunteers with Hershey, they come from York, Carlisle, Mechanicsburg, etc. and in groups so – quick response is a must as the listing fills up very quickly. You can sign up for as many shifts as you want. Preferably come back with more than one shift because they are taken very rapidly.

Not only do you receive a free voucher to the park, but IT IS FUN!

The Palmyra Pistol Team shoots conventional indoor pistol and has been competing in the William Penn Pistol League since 1946. There have been more than a few great shooters to shoot for the Palmyra team over the years. This is a .22 caliber league, which sports 10 different teams, 7 different clubs, and over 250 participants. You can use either iron sights or scopes (No projected lasers). We practice on Monday nights (7pm-9pm) and compete on Wednesday nights, September through Mid-April. There are 27 matches per season and it costs \$5 per match.

Conventional Pistol, otherwise known as Bullseye Pistol, is a challenging shooting sport, which utilizes precision, patience, and concentration and will make all your shooting sports better.

Action Handgun

Action Handgun Range

- Absolutely **NO** gun handling when anyone is down range.
- Eye and ear protection are mandatory for all shooters and spectators on the Action Handgun Range/Pit.
- Stand back 10 yards minimum when shooting steel plates to avoid the possibility of being hit by lead and bullet jacket fragments.
- Do not use magnum calibers or their equivalent when shooting steel plates. They damage the mechanisms and plate surfaces.
- Use paper targets when shooting magnum calibers.
- Do not use centerfire rifles, carbines or shotguns. They damage the mechanisms and plate surfaces.
- Do not use handguns that fire centerfire rifle cartridges. They damage the mechanisms and plate surfaces.
- Do not use shotguns on the Action Handgun Range. They damage the mechanisms and plate surfaces.
- Help keep your Action Handgun Range clean. Police your brass and deposit it in the receptacle at the rear of the range marked "BRASS". Do not move targets from their current positions. If you move tables, please return them to where you found them. Trash barrels are provided at the rear of the range. Please make sure all your trash is placed in these barrels when you leave the range.
