## PA State International Pistol Championships

On December 10, 2011 Palmyra Sportsmen's Assoc. hosted the 2011 PA International Pistol Championships.

This is the second year in a row where one shooter won both matches. Bob Lineaweaver won the Air Pistol match with a 562/600. Jeff Lutz led the Ma/Ex class with a 556. Darian Shenk defended her high Junior and Woman's title posting a 555. Darian also claimed the SS/Un division.

Bob Lineaweaver has been working on his international shooting all year; no one was surprised when he won the free pistol match with a score of 528/600. Rick Eickhoff reemerged from a long break to claim 2nd place with a 509. For the second year in a row, the Women's champion is Cori Hardison with a 354.

This year we fielded an Air Pistol team in the NRA State Postal match. This must be shot at or in conjunction with the State championship. This year's team consists of Bob Lineaweaver, Jeff Lutz, Darian Shenk, Joel Mackey and Sam Shenk. The team score is 2740 – 146 points higher than last year!

We had 28 entries between the 2 events this year – up from 17, last year's total. I hope this is a sign of international shooting growing in our state.

**Rifle Team**

The junior rifle team has been active throughout the fall getting ready for the Pennsylvania State Junior Olympic Championships which were hosted at our club over two weekends in December. This year's Junior Olympics had the largest number of participants, 92 in total, competing in both smallbore and air rifle events with men and women competing independently. In the men's smallbore events, the top 3 places went to Palmyra juniors, Nathan Brandeburg (572), Leo Funk (570), and Alex Gestl (568). In the smallbore women's event, Abby Wert ended up taking the Gold with a personal best of 570. Several others in smallbore had some very nice scores including Alyssa Gestl, Briann Derr, Elizabeth Embeck, Caleb Lloyd, Kevin Brubaker, Luke Johnson, and Josh Martin. The Palmyra teams did very well in smallbore finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> overall. The winning team was composed of Abby, Liz, and Leo and was just 8 points ahead of the second place of Nathan, Josh, and Alyssa. For air rifle, the Palmyra men again took top honors, Josh with a 573 and Nathan took third with a

568. The Palmyra women didn't fair quite as well with Elizabeth firing a 381 and finishing 8<sup>th</sup> overall. Others firing nice air rifle scores included Jessica Smith, Kaleb Hawryluk, Rob Smith, Briann, Leo, and Luke. In the team event, some of the Palmyra teams finished in 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> places. Other juniors competing included David Sheffey, Grant Kent, Griffin McElwee, Cullen Wargo, Kyle Ordille, Jerika Feaser, and Sam Funk. In addition to being the state championships, this match is also the qualifier to the national championships in Colorado Springs in April. Last year 10 juniors qualified for the nationals and this year there should be at least 12 that qualify with the possibility of up to 15. Overall, this was an excellent performance by our juniors.

**Action Handgun Range**

- Do not use magnum calibers or their equivalent when shooting steel plates.
- Use paper targets when shooting magnum calibers.
- Stand back 10 yards minimum when shooting steel plates.
- Eye and ear protection mandatory for shooter or spectator.
- **Do not use centerfire rifles, carbines or shotguns.**
- Do not use handguns that fire centerfire rifle cartridges.
- Help keep your shooting range clean.

**.22 Rimfire Sunday Shoots**

- Our Sunday .22 action rimfire shooting will resume on May 6, 2012, weather permitting.
- Time is 10 AM to 4 PM every Sunday, all summer, weather permitting.
