

2010 PENNSYLVANIA
STATE USA SHOOTING JUNIOR OLYMPIC
AIR PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

DATE: Sunday - January 3, 2010

LOCATION: Palmyra Sportsmen Assoc, Palmyra, Pa

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all competitors born in 1990 or later. All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting. (\$20 enrollment can be paid at the match).

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the scorecard. All residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Non-residents may compete for automatic and at-large invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so.

STATE RESIDENT QUALIFIERS: USA Shooting will issue official invitations to the National Junior Olympic Shooting Championships (NJOSC), for the high male and high female from each State JOPC, provided they fire a minimum qualifying score. Resident collegiate and/or military competitors are eligible for the state resident champion awards and are also eligible for resident state qualifier invitations.

ENTRY: Shooters may not compete in more than one state JOSC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSC and those who cannot attend their own state JOSC will be allowed to enter the automatic/at-large division in other states. At entry, non-resident juniors must declare if they are shooting for an at-large/automatic invitation.

Residents may choose to enter the Automatic/at-large category instead of the Resident Qualifier category if they are confident they can shoot above the automatic score and secure an invitation. This would allow another competitor to receive the State Qualifier invitation.

- A. Resident Qualifier - Competitors shooting in their declared state of permanent residency. Competitors in this category are eligible to be the state resident qualifier to the National JOSC.
- B. Automatic/At Large – Competitors shooting in other than their declared state of residency are eligible for at-large/automatic invitations to the National JOSC.

TEAMS: All teams entered in the team competition must represent USAS affiliated clubs. Teams will consist of three firing members.

CATEGORIES: The following categories will be used for individual and team competition: (Based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2010).

Junior (J1); age 18-20; competitors born from 1990-1992

Intermediate Junior (J2); age 15-17; competitors born from 1993-1995

Sub-Junior (J3); age 14 & under; competitors born in 1996 or later

RULES: Current USA Shooting Rules will govern. Scoring by officials. All ties will be broken in accordance with USA Shooting Rules.

PISTOL: .177 Cal. Air pistol, metallic sights only.

COURSE OF FIRE: All one-hand hold. Men – 60 shots in 1 hour, 45 minutes;
Women – 40 shots in 1 hour, 15 minutes. Target – air pistol B-40 (4-bull);
Distance 10 meters (33 ft.) Coaching will not be permitted.

RELAY TIMES: 2 p.m.

FEES: A USA Shooting registration fee of \$8.00 per individual will be sent to USA Shooting with scores at the completion of the match.

Total individual entry fee \$10.00.

PARTICIPATION PINS: A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.

AWARDS: In addition to the medallions provided by USA SHOOTING, the sponsor (Palmyra Sportsmen' Assoc.) will provide a first place award (if 3 or more competitors) and 2nd place award (if 7 or more competitors) in each class (Jr., Int., and Sub-Jr.).

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE:

>From the East: I-78 West to I-81 South. Take Exit 85. Turn left off exit onto Rt. 934 South to Annville (about 7 miles). Turn Right onto Rt. 422 West to Palmyra (about 4 miles). At 4th red light (Friendly Restaurant on Right), turn right onto Forge Rd. Go 1.8 miles to Sportsmen's Road. Follow Sportsmen's Road 2/10 of mile to Club property. After passing under Club sign, take first road to right.

- or -

Take I-76 (PA Turnpike) to Exit 266 / Old Exit 20 (Lebanon/Hershey). Turn left off exit onto Rt. 72 to Rt. 322 West. At the 3rd red light, turn right onto Airport Road. Go to first red light. Go straight through onto Forge Road. Go 1.8 miles to Sportsmens Road. Follow Sportsmens Road 2/10 of mile to Club property. After passing under Club sign, take first road to right.

>From the West: Take I-76 (PA Turnpike) to Exit 247 / Old Exit 19 (Harrisburg East). After going through toll booth, go straight ahead onto Rt./ 283 to Rt. 322 East. Follow 322 East to Rt. 422 East.

Go through Hershey & Palmyra till you get to Forge Road (Friendly's Restaurant on left/Klick Lewis car dealer on right).

Turn left. Follow Forge Road 1.8 miles to Sportsmens Road. Take Sportsmens Road 2/10 miles to Club property. After passing under the Club sign, take the first road to the right.

>From the South: Take I-83 North through Harrisburg to Rt. 322 East to Rt. 422 East. Follow 422 East through Hershey and Palmyra till you get to Forge Road (Friendly's Restaurant on left/Klick Lewis car dealer on right). Turn left. Follow Forge Road 1.8 miles to Sportsmens Road. Take Sportsmens Road 2/10 mile to Club property. After passing under the Club sign, take the first road to the right.
