# PALMYRA INDOOR ARCHERY WINTER LEAGUE 2022 HANDBOOK



# **INTRO**

Please join us this winter for fun, fellowship, and of course shooting. All members of the club are welcome to participate, regardless of skill level or type of equipment you use. Worried you're not good enough, NONSENSE. Teams are based on averages that are closely matched together to make competitive teams, so no need to worry. There are 2 divisions to choose from (300-600). Please see following pages for descriptions.

# **300 DIVISION RULES**

This division is for those that have very busy schedules, just want to keep your shooting form for hunting, or are developing your archery skills. You will shoot a 300 round every week, which consist of shooting 3 arrows for 10 rounds, or ½ of a scorecard. (Scorecards can be found in the silver box by the targets).

## **600 DIVISION RULES**

This division is for those who are more serious about shooting, whether it is to practice for the Indoor Invitational's, love to shoot, or just want the extra challenge. You will shoot a 600 round every week, which consists of shooting 3 arrows for 20 rounds or a whole scorecard.

# **AVERAGES**

Averages are used to make competitive teams and to give you a starting point. New Shooters will need to hand in 3 scorecards from your division and returning shooters 2 before the cutoff date. We will be counting x's as an extra point, this allows for top shooters to be more competitive and puts an extra twist in shooting for fun. Averages along with \$35.00 must be handed in (may be put in the green box in the archery range) by January 2,2022 by 9:00am. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

# **RULES**

- 1. Shooter may choose to shoot a single face or a 3 dot target for scores.
- 2. May shoot Recurves, barebow, long bows, crossbows and compounds for the League.
- 3. The shooting week begins on a Sunday and ends on Saturday.
- 4. We want to try to shoot on Thurs nights between 6-9pm. However, we realize this will not suit everyone's schedule. Therefore, you are permitted to shoot at times that work for you. We shoot on this day to allow people to get to know each other and allow for some friendly competition.
- 5. During league competition, you must have a score turned in no later then 2 weeks after the posted begin date of that week. If this occurs your score will be penalized. We will take your current running average and minus 5 points from that. This will be your score for the missed week.
- 6. You may only shoot 2 weeks ahead of a posted begin date.
- 7. Any one not completing the league scores, will not be eligible for awards.
- 8. Points are award to each team every week based on performance. A teams average cannot go down, it can only go up. Averages are based on 50% of scores for that week. Example: your team scores 50 points over last weeks team average-we only take 25 points towards the new average. This keeps good and bad days in check. The team/teams with the highest points at the end will receive an award at the end.
- 9. Half of the money collected during league competition will be used as prize payout.
- 10. In the case of a tie, there will be a shoot off held, to determine first and second place.

# **IMPORTANT DATES AND COST**

- 1. Averages and \$35 due by Jan 2, 2022 at 9am. No Exceptions!
- 2. League will begin the week of Jan 9, 2022.
- 3. League will end the week of March 20, 2022
- 4. The cost is \$35.00 The league runs for 10 weeks.
- 5. All scores must be completed by March 27th.
- 6. Please be aware that range will be closed because of our Invitational on Dec31 and Jan 1,2, On Fri from 7pm -12mid and7:30am to 5pm on both Sat and Sunday

### We will continue:

We are trying to make the shooters who shoot near the top more competitive, therefore, we are going to be counting x's as an extra point for everyone. So instead of being worth 10pts they will be worth 11pts. We hope this adds more excitement into the shooting game. So your averages will be based on a 330 or a 660.

Please try to shoot scores on a Thursday Night between 6-9pm. Trying to make this fun for all. This is a social event. However, we know that not everyone can and that's ok.
