TIME/AGENDA:

- Registration from 8:00am to 9:15am.
- Sight in and practice from 8:00am to 9:15am.
- Shooter's meeting at 9:15am.
- Rifle match begins at 9:30am.

MATCH FEES: \$15

COMPETITION: Open to all shooters willing to compete safely and in good sportsmanship.

RANGE CAPACITY: Limited to 45 shooters.

CLASSIFICATION: PCP and Spring Piston Rifle for AAFTA Open, WFTF, and Hunter classes.

RULES: Current AAFTA rules will apply. A 20 foot-pound energy maximum (fpe) applies to all rifles.

SOUADDING: Squads of 2 to 3 competitors, starting on randomly assigned start lanes.

PROGRAM:

- The match will consist of 30 targets, 2 shots per target, for a total of 60 shots.
- Competitors will have 5 minutes per lane to address the lane and take their 4 shots for score. Timers will be used during the match.
- Target distances will be between 10 and 55 yards.
- There will be forced position standing and kneeling lanes. The standing position can be shot in lieu of kneeling.

- The match will be shot straight through with no lunch break. Competitors are responsible for their own food and drink. Limited beverages and snacks are available for purchase at our club house.
- Tie breakers will be determined by total lane score, with lanes chosen in the following order until the tie is broken.
 - 1. Forced position standing lanes in descending order of most difficult target on lane.
 - 2. Non-forced position lanes in descending order of most difficult target on lane.
 - 3. Forced position kneeling lanes in descending order of most difficult target on lane.
 - 4. Shoot off match, or other agreed terms of the tied shooters (i.e. coin flip)

GENERAL INFO:

- Safety first, last, and always
- Everyone is a safety officer. If you observe an unsafe condition, immediately call for a cease fire and report it to the match director
- The use of eye protection is required per PSA rules
- Do not go forward of the firing line unless instructed to do so.
- Always keep loaded rifles pointed downrange
- Rifles should not be loaded and should be placed in a bag, case, or cradle when not on the firing line. If using a cradle, be aware of your muzzle and ensure it is pointed in a safe direction.
- Flagrant unsafe actions and unsportsmanlike behavior are grounds for removal from the competition and club property, with no refund of match fees.

DIRECTIONS:

From the East: I-78 West to I-81 South. Take Exit 85. Turn left off exit onto Rt. 934 South to Annville (about 7 miles). Turn Right onto Rt. 422 West to Palmyra (about 4 miles). At 4th red light, turn right onto Forge Rd. Go 1.8 miles to Sportsmens Road. Follow Sportsmens Road 2/10 of mile to Club property.

Take I-76 (PA Turnpike) to Exit 266 Lebanon/Hershey (old Exit 20). Turn left off exit onto Rt. 72 to Rt. 322 West. At the 3rd red light, turn right onto Airport Road. Go to first red light. Go straight through onto Forge Road. Go 1.8 miles to Sportsmens Road. Follow Sportsmens Road 2/10 of mile to Club property.

From the West: Take I-76 (PA Turnpike) to Exit 247 Harrisburg East (old Exit 19). After going through toll booth, go straight ahead onto Rt./ 283 to Rt. 322 East. Follow 322 East to Rt. 422 East. Go through Hershey & Palmyra till you get to Forge Road (CVS drug store on left/Klick Lewis car dealer on right). Turn left. Follow Forge Road 1.8 miles to Sportsmens Road. Take Sportsmens Road 2/10 miles to Club property.

From the South: Take I-83 North to Harrisburg. Take Rt. 322 East to Rt. 422 East. Follow 422 East through Hershey and Palmyra till you get to Forge Road (CVS drug store on left/Klick Lewis car dealer on right). Turn left. Follow Forge Road 1.8 miles to Sportsmens Road. Take Sportsmens Road 2/10 mile to Club property.

<u>AFTER ENTERING</u> the Club property, navigate to the Competition Rifle Range. To get to this range, after passing under the club's sign, take the road to the right (runs along the top of the hill). Follow the road into a stone parking lot and take the road that goes between the covered rifle and pistol ranges. The rifle range is the left most covered range. You can park at the rifle range, or in the stone parking lot previously mentioned.
