## Indoor Pistol Range Rules

- 1. ABSOLUTELY NO FIREARM HANDLING while anyone is downrange.
- 2. Eye and Ear protection are mandatory for ANYONE in the range, including spectators and children.
- 3. When entering and leaving the range, All firearms are to be cased or holstered. If firearms are not cased, actions must be open and unloaded. No ammunition in the firearm(s).
- 4. The ONLY targets are Paper Targets hung from the target posts.
- 5. All Firearm Discharges must be pointed downrange at the backstops. a. No shooting from Cross Draw Holsters.
- Shooting distances in front of the tables requires a common firing line.
  a. No firearms handling behind the common firing line.
- 7. Caliber Rules for Indoor Range:
  - a. Straight Wall pistol calibers only, NO Magnum calibers, .45 max caliber.
  - b. Recommend target or lower velocity loads only.
  - c. NO FULL AUTO ALLOWED.
  - d. **No** Centerfire Rifle or Shotgun cartridges are allowed.
  - e. **NO** Tracer ammo allowed.
  - f. Lead and Copper Plated-Jacketed Ammo only.
  - g. NO Metal core Ammo Allowed
- 8. NO Smoking or Eating while on the range.
- 9. Prospective Member policy: See posted signs.
- 10. Violations of the range rules: MEMBERS WILL BE FINANCIALLY LIABLE for damages incurred.
- 11. This is your club, as a member you are part owner, maintain and police as your own.
- 12.All members and guests must display membership badge or guest pass.
- 13. When going downrange, past the firing line, all shooters must agree the range is cold.
- 14. When ready to fire, all shooters must agree the range is hot.

## Definitions:

- **Cold Range**: All firearms must have open actions, unloaded, no ammo in chamber, magazine detached and step away from the firearm.
- Hot Range: All shooters are back behind the firing line and all shooters confirm they are ready to shoot.
